**Cyber Security for Schools and Colleges Core standards** 

All schools and colleges should be working towards meeting 6 core standards by 2030:

<u>broadband internet</u> connection type, connection speed, resilience and safeguarding.

<u>wireless network</u> wireless network performance, coverage, management and security.

<u>network switching</u> switch performance, management, security and resilience.

digital leadership and governance roles and responsibilities filtering and monitoring appropriate filtering and monitoring cyber security reduce risks related to a cyber incident by preventing access to potentially malicious sites or resources
